SIX SHOOTER

Six Shooter is made up of a collation of experienced musicians that have been together since October 2009. They are made up of swaggering front man Paddy Baker (27), lead guitarist Paul Lowther (21), beefy drummer David 'Shammy' Samuels (24), bassist Mike Gallagher (21) and lead guitarist Andy Blackmore (27).

Six Shooter are infused with the twin lead British classic rock style inspired by such giants as Led Zeppelin, Deep Purple, Thin Lizzy, Whitesnake, Thunder and Jimi Hendrix. However, they have given new life to this genre by bringing influence from the raw power and emotion of blues-rock and the arrangement and rhythmic power of funk and Motown, with the flair of the great stadium rock bands of the 70's.

This is a band born of live performance in the classic way, always looking to be a formidable act first and foremost, with a tight-as-a-nut set. This has led to Six Shooter being booked to play over 60 shows across Devon and Cornwall in just over a year, as of February 2011, averaging a gig a week. Crowds seem to be drawn to their captivating live experience and the hook-laden melodic rock, which has encouraged a large and loyal following.

Six Shooter are also equally happy in the studio, and record competently with the flair that is expected of them on stage, which has led to their tracks being played on many radio stations. So far they have garnered support from Plymouth FM, Exeter FM, Pirate FM (Cornwall), Riviera FM (Devon), Plymouth University's in-house radio, Plymouth Hospital's Radio, and has even achieved national interest through airtime on BBC Radio Devon with two separate DJ's. This has seen the band pushed for slots on the BBC introducing show for BBC 6 Music.

Six Shooter have also had success in competition formats with a victory by a clear margin in the Torbay Battle of the Bands in May 2010, followed by a finalist spot in the South West of England Battle of the Bands based in Plymouth in September 2010. This gained Six Shooter extensive coverage in the local press, which showered accolades on the band for their mesmerizing live performance and their most accomplished and polished sound. It is because of this that Six Shooter has been head-hunted to play this year at the Tavisrock and Blues Festival in one of the most sought-after evening slots.

Six Shooter have also achieved great success in the Live and Unsigned 2011 national competition. They have progressed through the first auditions and the regional finals, both of which were held in Plymouth, and are now just one gig away from playing at London's O2 Arena. They are competing nationally in the Area Finals which are to be held at Portsmouth Guildhall on Saturday 21st May. From over 800 bands from Devon, Cornwall and Somerset; Six Shooter are one of only 21 bands who have made it this far.

All of this brings Six Shooter to the present day. The band has released a self-financed eight track album entitled 'Beats Four Aces', which has been guaranteed airplay on six different radio stations, has acquired full-page spreads in local papers, and is to be sold in a number of Plymouth-based music stores.

Six Shooter can potentially be a nationally-renowned live and recording act, but it is in need of a partnership that can help the band succeed to its maximum potential, and provide the basis to make the future mutually beneficial to anyone who invests in our unique sound.
